**Biophytis to participate at the BIO International Convention
in Boston from the 5th to the 8th of June**

Paris (France), Cambridge (Massachusetts, United States), June 5th, 2023 – 8am CET - Biophytis SA (NasdaqCM: BPTS, Euronext Growth Paris: ALBPS), (**“Biophytis” or the “Company”**), a clinical-stage biotechnology company focused on the development of therapeutics that slow the degenerative processes associated with aging, including severe respiratory failure in patients suffering from COVID-19, today announces it will participate at the Biotechnology Innovation Organization (BIO) International Convention to be held in Boston from the 5th to the 8th of June 2023, alongside thousands of world leaders in biotechnology and the pharmaceutical industry.

Biophytis' participation in BIO is aligned with the Company's strategy to partner with global or regional players for its main drug candidates developed in age-related diseases, in particular sarcopenia, and in rare neuromuscular diseases, in particular Duchenne muscular dystrophy.

Sarconeos (BIO101), our leading drug candidate, is a small molecule, administered orally, planned to be developed as a treatment for sarcopenia in upcoming Phase 3 clinical trials in the United States, Brazil and Europe (SARA-31 and SARA-32). It has also been studied in a clinical two-part Phase 2-3 study (COVA) for the treatment of severe respiratory manifestations of COVID-19 in Europe, Latin America, and the US. A pediatric formulation of Sarconeos (BIO101) is being developed for the treatment of Duchenne Muscular Dystrophy (DMD). The Company is based in Paris, France, and Cambridge, Massachusetts. The Company's ordinary shares are listed on Euronext Growth (Ticker: ALBPS -ISIN: FR0012816825) and ADSs (American Depositary Shares) are listed on Nasdaq Capital Market (Ticker BPTS – ISIN: US09076G1040).
